### NEW OR RENEWAL OF BUSINESS TAX APPLICATION

On September 19, 2012 Governor Brown signed into law SB-1186 which adds a state fee of \$1 on any applicant for a local business license or similar instrument or permit, or renewal thereof. The purpose is to increase disability access and compliance with construction-related accessibility requirements and to develop educational resources for businesses in order to facilitate compliance with federal and state disability laws, as specified. Under federal and state law, compliance with disability access laws is a serious and significant responsibility that applies to all California building owners and tenants with buildings open to the public. You may obtain information about your legal obligations and how to comply with disability access laws at the following agencies:

## What is a SIC Code?

Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) codes are four-digit numerical codes assigned by the U.S. government to business establishments to identify the primary business of the establishment. The classification was developed to facilitate the collection, presentation and analysis of data; and to promote uniformity and comparability in the presentation of statistical data collected by various agencies of the federal government, state agencies and private organizations. The classification covers all economic activities. (See: <u>What is a NAICS Code?</u>)

The SIC system arrays the economy into 11 divisions, that are divided into 83 2-digit major groups, that are further subdivided into 416 3-digit industry groups, and finally disaggregated into 1,005 4-digit industries.

### How DO BUSINESSES USE SIC CODES? - https://siccode.com/

- Companies use SIC codes to identify customers by industry code.
- Professionals use SIC codes to segment markets for marketing campaigns and customer research
- Companies append SIC codes to their customer list to determine what industries their customers operate in. For future marketing campaigns, companies know which industries to further market to.
- For business lists, SIC codes are more specific and comprehensive than NAICS codes.
- To identify competitors, public and private
- Companies that operate in a certain industry use a specific SIC code when filing with the SEC so that the type of business is properly identified

- Your business SIC code is often asked for on various applications and forms.
- Lenders use SIC codes to help identify the industry affiliation of your company. Therefore, it's vital to ensure that you have the correct SIC code for your business classification

SIC codes have been defined by the U.S. Government as the most exact industry classification. Use SIC codes for targeting purposes by accessing the 15+ million SIC code directory of companies. Identify your current customers by their SIC code and find new clients within the same or similar industries. SIC codes are required for state registration, federal registration, tax purposes, when filing your DUNS number, and when seeking eligibility for government contracts.
